This is especially beneficial when feeding multiple pets of varying ages in a household.

Remember to transition gradually from your dog or cat's current diet to Nature's Domain™ in order to prevent digestive upset that can be associated with a sudden diet change.

- When you are ready to switch to an adult food (we recommend at 5 months of age) you can transition by:

Day 1: 75% current food / 25% new food

Day 2: 50/50

Day 3: 25% current / 75% new

Day 4: 100% new food
